### Who was Toby Landgraf?

Toby is fondly remembered saying, "Education is the key to everything."

As evidence, many still recall Toby's "new guy schools" that he ran for several years for those new to equipment sales. They were never brand-specific, but always professionally done. Those who attended left better equipped to sell heavy food service equipment than when they arrived.

That tradition was carried on by Toby's family after his untimely death in 1985 at age 38. Memorial gifts to the family were pooled by the Landgrafs and given to the University of Wisconsin-Stout to endow a scholarship fund in Toby's name. These scholarships are awarded by the Food Service degree program for students from Minnesota.

## **Celebrating 26 years of the Toby Landgraf Golf tournament.**

The Toby Landgraf tournament was created when a group of Toby's industry friends sought an event that would provide continuous funding to the Stout endowment. Golf was Toby's favorite pastime and education was his passion. To anyone who would bemoan the "state of the industry," Toby always had a one-word solution: Education.

With those goals in mind, the first Toby Tournament was held at Minnesota Valley Country Club in 1986. Jerry Kopveiler of Harrison House/Monarch Foods was the first chairman and Lloyd Hollander of Hollander Company the first treasurer.

As the tournament grew in size and success, the committee decided to share proceeds with both Stout and the St. Paul Technical College Foundation. The latter, until 2009, provided Toby Scholarships in the food service programs to several of Minnesota's Technical Colleges, and Stout itself has awarded 108 scholarships. In 2010 the American Culinary Federation's Minneapolis Chapter took over the distributing Toby scholarship funds for the Minnesota schools. The application and awarding process is done through the ACF chapter's extensive outreach program for its own scholarship initiatives and its significant online presence. The first five Toby Scholarships were awarded through the ACF November 2010.

This year the Toby foundation has added its own web presence. We now have a web page that includes the Toby scholarship foundations mission, old photos of the event and recipients, how to register for Toby event and most importantly the Toby scholarship application for future recipients. Total contributions from the tournament these past 25 years have exceeded \$500,000, and hundreds of students have been helped. Nearly 150 industry members have given time and talent as committee members to make this possible.

Finally, all those who have joined as tournament participants—players, hole sponsors, gift donors, etc.—are the major contributors to the success we've enjoyed. It couldn't have happened without you.
